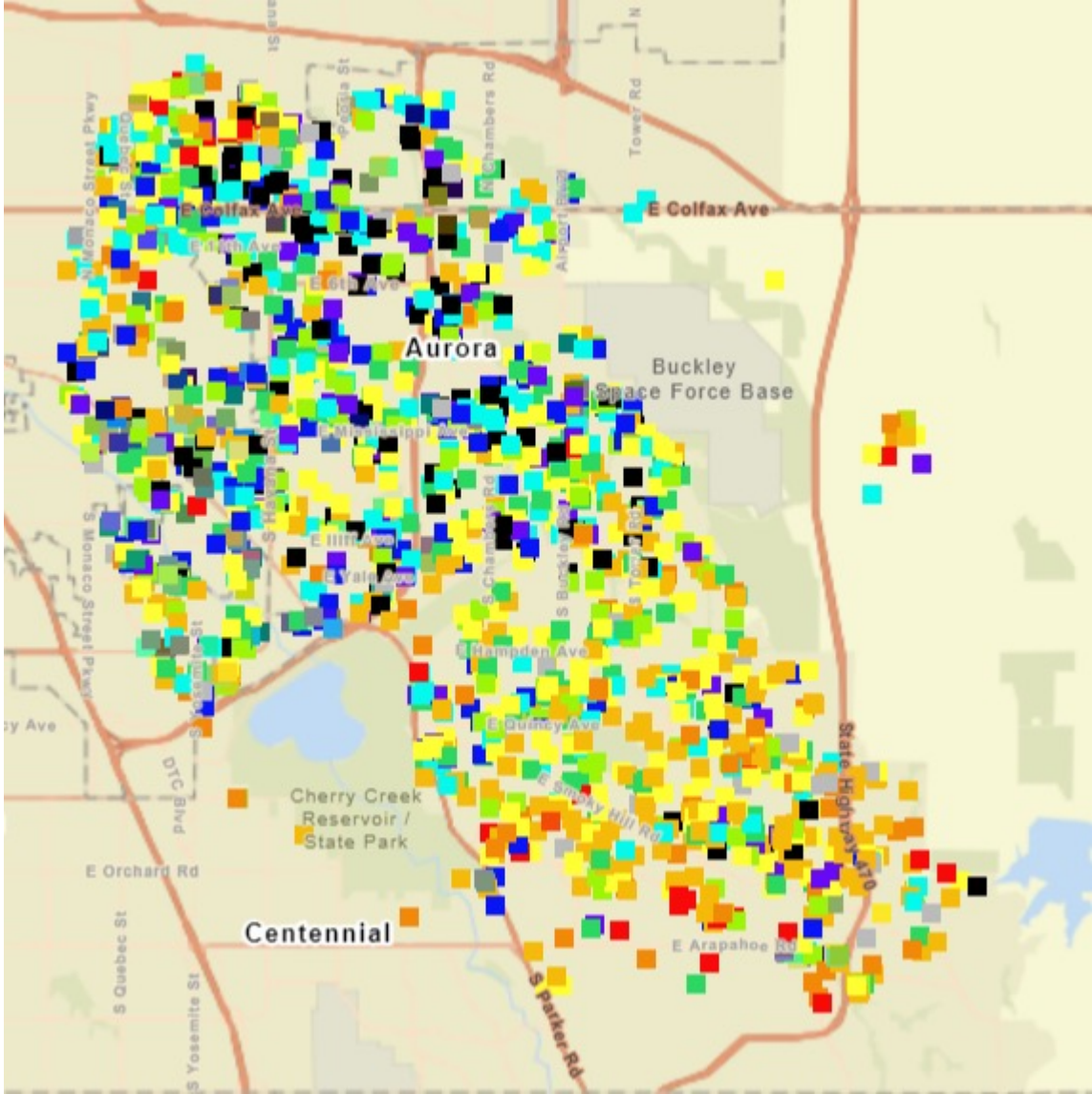
What do my adult learners want to study?

Targeted Recruitment

You already know these students and what they are looking for

- Don't waste their time with generalize recruitment material
- Geofencing
- Mailers (Oddly, people like these again? Wild times.)
- Calling Campaigns (where data available)

Identify Gaps

Are there programs where students have high interest that are also aligned with workforce needs that we are not offering?

- Do we have the infrastructure to start that program?
- Would there be funding from the state to help meet this workforce need?
- Is this a long-term need or a short-term need?
